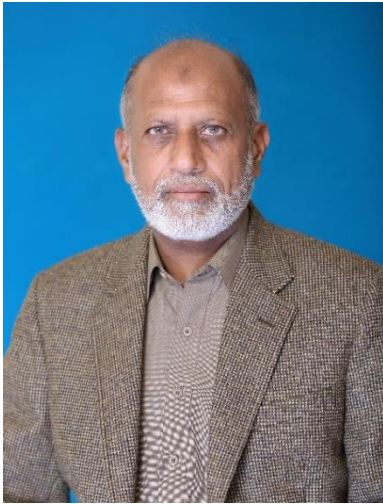

**IRSA Welcomes Amjad Saeed as Member IRSA Punjab**

**IRSA Advisory Committee (IAC) Meeting**

A meeting of the IAC was held on 05.10.2021 to take up agenda which could not be taken up in the previous IAC meeting held on 30.09.2021. The decisions taken were under:

- PID Balochistan shall prepare a comprehensive working paper, preferably in a week's time, on practical and sustainable solutions to short supplies to Balochistan Canals, to be put up before Authority meeting.
- WAPDA shall provide a comparison of the outflow capacity of Tarbela during the execution of works with historic provincial irrigation requirements/ indents worked out by IRSA on ten-daily basis. Such information shall be shared by WAPDA with IRSA and all the provinces within a week's time.

- IWMI would prepare a detailed Joint Discharge Measurement (JDM) methodology preferably within a week's time and share it with IRSA and all the provinces. This methodology shall include, time-period required; any specific months for activity depending on river hydrology; data required from the provinces (RTs, canals data, etc); input from IRSA; equipment required for the activity and its provisioning arrangements, etc.

**Operational News:-**

The actual provincial canal utilization vis-à-vis shares from October 01 to 31, 2021 remained 3% excess than anticipated likely shares.

**Rim-Station Inflows**

The overall Rim-stations inflows from October 01 to 31, 2021 remained 23% above anticipations.
